To achieve the above objectives, the **SAFE Guide** contains the following information:

- General information on flying in Europe and flying in specific conditions
- Information about specific rules as well as operational differences in the application of ICAO rules by each European country as well as the firsthand experience of the authors and co-operating pilots.
- The **SAFE Guide** contains several filters which allow each user to quickly find the airports that match his/her criteria (controlled/uncontrolled; grass/concrete runways; availability of accommodation or fuel etc.)
- The following data is currently provided for each of more than 2000 European airports:
 - *Type of airport (domestic/international, controlled/uncontrolled), indication of landing charges, friendliness, length, direction and surface type of the runway, availability of fuel, additional services*
 - *Each airport Website address and/or contacts, accommodation possibilities, points of interest in the vicinity etc.*
 - *A minimum one but usually more photos of each airport contained in the SAFE Guide*
 - *Spheric (360 degrees) flight videos of actual landings/departures or overflights for several hundred airports including all airports with concrete/asphalt runway. The number of videos is growing by the day.*
 - *Pilots' forum allowing for sharing experiences, recommendations, airport ratings, photos, videos etc.*
 - *Selected documents, articles, videos etc. to provide the SAFE Guide clients with additional information focused mainly on flight safety and VFR flight experience*
 - *Tourist information on the area of approximately 50 km radius around frequently visited airports in each country.*
